2:30 pm **Beef Cards Due** **Bucket calves will start 15 minutes after the Goat Show or at Judges discretion) **Beef Show will begin immediately

Morton County Spring Livestock Show 2024 General Rules

Morton County Extension, Morton County 4-H, Morton County Fair Association, show officials or show management will not be held responsible for any damage to or losses of property for the duration of the show.

The show management reserves the right to alter and/or combine classes as seen fit. Changes and or announcements made the day of the show take precedence over written rules, instructions, regulations, classes prizes, etc. The decision of the show management is final. Only 4-H and FFA members in good standing are eligible to enter.

NO protests are allowed. The decision of the show committee and judge(s) is final.

Any behavior inappropriate by a family member or exhibitor could result in immediate disqualification and forfeit all fees and prizes.

NO REFUNDS will be given after payment has been made.

Exhibitor MUST own and show their own animals including showmanship animals. (Exception: If exhibitor has 2 or more animals in the same Market or Breeding class) I the event the owner has been injured prior to the show (i.e., broken leg, ankle, arm) another 4-H'er may show for them in their perspective class except showmanship with prior approval from the show committee.

Livestock must be entered in Market OR Breeding classes. They CAN NOT show in both

Wethers and Ewes may be show in the Market Lamb show but must be show slick shorn

Wethers and Does may be shown in the Meat Goat Show but must be shown clipped to 3/8" or less. Breeding Does do not have to be clipped for the Breeding Doe Show. Goat classes will be divided by weight

Cattle, Sheep and Goats will be show free of fungus lesions, staph, etc. If they show any signs LEAVE THEM HOME!!!

All Sheep and Goats must be identified with an official USDA Premise ID tag. All swine, sheep goat, and market beef must have an official 4H tag and/or scrapie tag and must be on file at the County Extension Office

This is a BLOW and SHOW only. The use of paint,glue/adhesives,boning soaps will NOT be allowed. Additional power sources may be needed. Generators must be placed outside of buildings.

No intact males

Prospect Market and Breeding animal classes may be broken by weights with the breed as well. Heifer classes will be shown by breed and DOB. There must be at least three animals for a breed class, otherwise, they will show as AOB. Registrations papers for Breeding animals may be required for breed classification. Swine and sheep must be born on or after January 1st of current year. Goats must be born on or after December 1, 2023

Showmanship classes will be Senior (ages 14-19), Intermediate (ages 10-13, Junior ages 7-9) then Peewee (6 and under)
